Women's health related gynecological concerns?

There are many gynecological skin conditions including disorders that can affect vaginal health. Many of these skin conditions can cause itching, discomfort or lack of confidence.

Are gynecological skin conditions common?

Skin and soft tissue in the genital area and gynecological needs can change over time. These changes can be the result of childbirth, aging or changes in hormone levels.

Often, out of embarrassment, women avoid seeking medical help.

Problems affecting your vaginal health are nothing to be embarrassed about. Careful examination of the external genitalia, introitus and vaginal canal are an important part of the female health examination. If you experience gynecological skin changes in appearance (color or texture) or sensation, talk to a medical professional about what can help.

How can the CO₂RE laser treatment help my gynecological condition?

The CO₂RE Intima laser treatment is a simple and efficient energy-based solution that can treat tissue without any hormones.

Your physician may use the CO₂RE system to deliver laser energy to a targeted area of the skin, including along the vaginal wall. This delivery of energy stimulates a healing response and results in remodeling of the soft tissue. During the remodeling process, new collagen forms to revitalize the skin. There is generally little pain and discomfort with this minimally invasive procedure.

The procedure is convenient since it can be performed in your physician's office during your regular visits. The treatment is also efficient as it can take as little as 10 minutes.

Here are some gynecological skin conditions that women may experience and can be treated with the CO₂RE system:

- Vaginal atrophy (e.g. vaginal dryness and discomfort)
- Vaginal rejuvenation (e.g. changes affecting the vaginal canal)
- Signs of ageing in the vaginal area
- Surgical scar tissue

What can you expect following a CO₂RE system treatment?

The response to treatment will vary and results appear gradually. Speak with your physician about any side effects such as swelling, itching, discomfort, or minor pain that could occur with energy-based treatments. For a complete list of side effects, speak to your physician.
